List of required documents for an employee

after arrival in Cyprus with a visa issued by the consular authorities of the Republic abroad

***The below required documents vary depending on whether the permit is being renewed, changing of employer, or if the third-country national is already residing in Cyprus with a different residency permit

Document	Description	✓
Valid Passport	A copy of a valid passport or other travel document, with validity covering the required period of the permit. Original passport must be presented for verification when submitting the application.	
Passport Entry Page and Visa	A copy of the passport page showing the last arrival in Cyprus and the entry visa.	
Accommodation	Rental agreement duly stamped if valued over €5000 or property sale contract or title deed.	
Employment Contract or Job Offer	A signed and stamped employment contract or binding job offer for a highly qualified position, including job description and salary details.	
Blood Analysis and Medical Exam	Original blood analysis results showing the applicant is free from HIV, syphilis, Hepatitis B and C, and a chest x-ray for tuberculosis (TB), certified by a specialized doctor in Cyprus.	
Criminal Record Certificate	Original criminal record certificate from the country of origin, or country of residence if different. Documents must be ratified (e.g., apostilled or triple-certified) depending on the country of issuance. For example, documents from Russia and Serbia do not require ratification, only translation into English or Greek by a sworn translator.	
Health Insurance Certificate	A certificate of health insurance covering inpatient and outpatient care and transportation of corps.	
Higher Education	In relation to non-regulated professions, a true copy (by the issuing Authority) accompanied by an official translation into Greek or English of a higher education qualification of at least three years' duration.	
Professional Experience Certificate (ICT professions Only)	Certificates of professional experience of at least three (3) years, at a level equivalent to a higher education qualification, obtained within seven (7) years prior to applying for an EU Blue Card. These certificates must demonstrate the relevant professional qualifications for the occupation or sector outlined in the employment contract or binding job offer. The certificate must be an original or certified copy (from the employer), and should include employment dates, a detailed description of duties, the name, signature, and contact details of the signatory, as well as the official stamp of the employer.
